Notice to Mariners

Entry and Exit to Kilkeel Harbour

Notice is hereby given that entry or exit to Kilkeel Harbour is hazardous during winds force 5 and above from 105 °N to 225 °N i.e. in wind directions from approximately E to SW, due to the need to turn across the sea on entering the harbour. In these conditions there is a risk of 'broaching'.

The Northern Ireland Fishery Harbour Authority recommends that extreme caution is taken on entry or exit to Kilkeel Harbour when winds are force 5 or above from 105 °N to 225 °N i.e. from approximately E to SW.
